Chapter Board Profile:

Peg Duggan – Director of Operations

Director of Operations is now the new title for what was Director of Information Technology. One new change (and challenge) of this position is support for a “virtual setting” to support the Chapter Board.

Responsibilities of Operations include administration and updates to the member website, PMI-NH.org, as well as the workspace, email system and online voting that takes place for chapter board positions.

The “virtual setting” for the Board is now supported through use of a "cloud" workspace. This technology facilitates a number of activities. These include holding discussions, storing documents, sharing a common calendar, event planning, and managing chapter activities. While the “cloud” workspace has not totally replaced regular meetings by Chapter Board members, it has been an interesting experience to implement and presents a unique set of challenges.

Forward Thinking

As Director of Operations I've been able to help improve how the Board conducts chapter business and provide information to all chapter members.

Several new projects have been implemented or are underway. These include:

- o Selecting an email service provider and implementing a new process to create and deliver chapter communications
- o Developing a Privacy Policy for handling collection of personal information by the chapter.
- o Implementing online voting for chapter officer elections.
- o Review, selection and implementation of a new collaboration “cloud” workspace to facilitate business by the Board.

Chapter Website Update Project

Changes to the chapter website will begin in June. Recommendations will follow after an evaluation and review of the site.

Currently, website updates occur regularly with information for chapter meetings, PDU information, and study groups. There are plans to help enhance the web experience by adding new features such as an online calendar and RSS feeds.

Doing the Right Thing

The Director of Operations is a non-elected position with a 2-year commitment serving at the request of the President. As Director of Operations I have found the work challenging, the board supportive, and the experience fulfilling.

As Project Managers we all should contribute back to the organization and I urge you all to volunteer in some way, because we all have unique talents. It is a rewarding experience.
